Dear Sirs,

E. I duly received your letter of the 23rd instant respecting the air receivers proposed for Messrs.Soc. Anon.John Cockerill's Yard Nos.651 and 657, and with regard thereto have to acquaint you that the thickness of the dished-in end plate, as shown on the plan, is somewhat less than required in accordance with the Society's usual practice.

These air receivers will, however, be accepted in this instance, for a working pressure of 25 kg. per sq. cm., provided the receivers be tested by hydraulic pressure and show no signs of strain. In this connexion I have to request that special attention be given to the dished-in end plates.

One copy of the plan is being returned under separate cover.
