IT IS SUBMITTED the Antwerp Surveyors be informed that the thicknesses of dielectric and lead sheath of the single core sample of cable are less than those required by the Rules *and cannot be accepted*

In the case of the two core cable, these dimensions comply with the Rule requirements. *The tape used to surround the dielectric is to be waterproof as required by the Rules; that used in the samples is not waterproof.* It should be pointed out that the diameter <sup>is</sup> of the armouring wires/less than the Rule size, and this type of armoured cable could not be accepted <sup>for situations</sup> ~~in cases~~ where the Rules require armoured cable to be used.

In other respects, the construction complies with the Rules, and <sup>similar</sup> ~~such~~ cables could be accepted provided the Rule requirements for thickness of dielectric, thickness of lead covering and testing of cables be complied with.

The information contained in the letter is noted, and it is concluded that plans of the cable layout and switchboards will be submitted in due course.
