M. Dear Sirs,
I am returning under separate cover two sets of the plans, forwarded with Mr. Wray's letter of the 21st instant, of Schat Davits Type "PHA" intended for Messrs. Cockerill's No. 657, and with regard thereto I have to state that provided the davits be constructed as shewn and to your satisfaction, they will be approved for the maximum load and outreach indicated on the plans.

The steel to be used in the construction of these davits must be made by the Open Hearth process at works recognised by the Committee, and must be tested by the Surveyors in accordance with the requirements of the Rules.

It will be necessary for you to satisfy yourselves that the workmanship is sound and to pay special attention to the electric welding of the davits. The Rules for the Application of Electric Arc Welding to Ship Construction must be complied with, and electrodes used complying with Clauses 1-9, Section 4 of these Rules.

The third set of plans is being retained for record.
