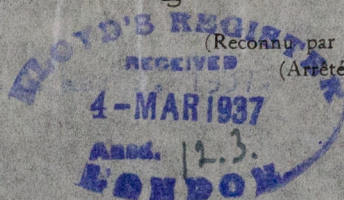

We beg to submit for the consideration of the Committee a plan shewing a step in the tween deck aft in vessel No. 657, to be built by Messrs. Cockerills at Hoboken.

As will be observed the height of the tween deck is increased from 1.98 to 2.10 metres with the break in the deck at No. 14 frame as shewn in the detail sketch.

The proposed attachment of the deck plating to the shell in way of the after peak tank is also shewn.

The plan referred to is being forwarded in triplicate under separate cover.
