M Dear Sir,

With reference to the motor vessel No.657 to be built by Messrs.Cockerill at Hoboken, we beg to submit for the consideration of the Committee a plan shewing a modification to the double bottom in way of the main engine.

As will be observed the depth of the centre girder has been reduced, at the request of the Engine Builders, from 775 mm to 662 mm and the centre girder plate between frames 10 to 18 increased in thickness.

The plan referred to is being forwarded in triplicate under separate cover.
