We are returning under separate cover the following plans, as amended and approved at this office:

Wiring diagram, coupling scheme (3926 a), switch-board (3927).

One copy of the plan No.895 - 150 (position of generators) is also being returned. It is concluded that the previous plans, submitted in your letter of the 18th March last, have been cancelled.

With reference to your letter of the 30th May last with enclosure, we beg to state that the proposed fuses of diazed pattern, if not of British Siemens make, have not yet been approved by the Society, but under the circumstances, they might be accepted in this instance, in view of the size of the installation.

The proposed protected covering of the cables has been noted; in this instance the cable run from aft to forward has to comply with Section 15 Clause 6 (a) (ii).
