These ships are employed in the Silver Java Pacific Line, which we operate together with Messrs.Stanley & John Thompson Ltd., London, Messrs.Stoomvaart Mij."Nederland", Amsterdam, and Rotterdamsche Lloyd, Rotterdam.

In said service there are regular shipments of palm oil from Singapore to Bombay and of coconut oil from Manila to the Pacific Coast. The actual quantities of oil lifted each sailing vary according to the requirements of the shippers, and it may not always be possible to get a quantity sufficient to accord exactly with the size of the tanks which are at disposal, i.e. it may be desirable to run one or more tanks "slack".

We are informed that Messrs.Stanley & John Thompson Ltd. have taken this matter up with you and got your authority to operate their ships with "slack" tanks in this particular

service. We will ask you to kindly take the matter into consideration also for our above three ships, which we are operating in the same service. We should appreciate to receive your permission accordingly.
