We beg to acknowledge your letter dated 4th inst., regarding the Casing we are making for above order, but regret we cannot possibly give you all the information.

It may be useful for you to know that we buy all our material, consisting of Plates, Joists, Sections, and small Flats, from well known British firms.

In connection with the order that you are now referring to, a good deal of the material was cut from our own stock, and as we always obtain copies of Works Test Certificates for stock material, we have pleasure in enclosing herewith three Certificates from the Consett Iron Co., Appleby Frodingham Steel Co. Ltd., and the Lilleshall Co.

In connection with the Certificate from the Consett Iron Co., this is an actual Test Certificate of the largest plates of all for the Casing, because we did not happen to have one suitable in our own Stock.

We do not know whether you would like to keep these Test Certificates, or better still forward same to Lloyd's Surveyor, but if so we are quite agreeable.
