Messrs. Swan, Hunter & Wigham Richardson Ltd.

Yard No. 1567. Engine No. 1606.

Reverting to your letter of the 21st. ult, and in particular the part referring to the safety valve, we have again contacted with Messrs. Shaw, Son & Greenhalgh Ltd. and have informed them of your requirements.

They have replied to the effect that their standard valve to suit your needs is only made in the larger sizes, but they are prepared to supply a special valve generally as shown on their Drawing 957, enclosed, but with easing gear and lock up arrangement similar to that shown on part drawing 11869, also attached.

These Drawings appear to us to be in order, except that we are not quite clear as to the provision you want to cover for Point 5. Presumably this is intended to refer to the discharge pipe from the safety valve, and we would, of course, advise Messrs. Swan, Hunter & Wigham Richardson that an open ended connection would be required at this point.
