Dear Sir,

We duly received your letter of the 11th instant, together with a copy of a letter from the Owners of the Steamer "HELM SPEY" regarding the date of build of the vessel.

In reply we beg to state that in order to complete the Special Survey for Classification the steering arrangements and the steam windlass require to be tried under working conditions. These items cannot be dealt with until steam is available on the vessel as stated in our letter of 2nd April 1930.

The Owners made a previous application for a later date of build under para. 9 (a) page 11 of the rules, in a letter addressed to the builders dated 31st March 1930 a copy of which was sent to you with our letter of the 2nd April 1930.

Our first entry report on the vessel has been held over pending the completion of the survey in accordance with the instruction contained in your reply of the 4th April 1930.
