I am in receipt of your letter of the 2nd instant, with its enclosures, from Messrs. J.L. Thompson & Son Ltd., respecting the date of build of their yard No. 569 (s.s. "HELMSPEY"), and note that to complete the first entry survey, the examination and testing of the windlass still require to be carried out, and that these items cannot be dealt with until steam is available on the vessel, which is not yet in commission.
