This vessel built in 1917 by Messrs. Bremer, Vulkan Vegesack, under the supervision of the Surveyors to the Germanischer Lloyd, is now at Falmouth undergoing survey with a view to classification with this Society.

The Surveyors have forwarded plans of the main boilers and pumping arrangements, and state this is a sister vessel to the s.s. "NORFOLK" ex "SAUERLAND" and s.s. "CUMBERLAND" ex "WENDLAND" previously reported upon by them and now classed with this Society.

The scantlings of the boilers as shewn on plan meet the requirements of the Rules in force at the time the boilers were constructed for the original working pressure of 199 lbs per square inch.

The pumping arrangements are also in order.

It is submitted that provided the requirements ^{REFERRING TO THE SISTER VESSELS "NORFOLK" & "CUMBERLAND"} contained in the Secretary's letters of 1st February, 1922, and 8th March 1922 respectively, be complied with, the machinery of the vessel might be accepted for the original working pressure of 199 lbs. per square inch and a record of LLMC (with date) without the distinguishing mark be assigned.
