A notation of 'Examined 4,42' valid for 12 months has been assigned.

The class is subject to shell plating in 1st and 2nd strakes below sheer and framing being dealt with at the first opportunity.

The CAPE TOWN Surveyors report (7,42) the vessel examined afloat on account of damage through heavy weather and repairs effected to outboard flange of starboard hawse pipe, f'cle side scuttle and a number of deck fittings.

It is submitted the vessel appears worthy to remain as classed subject as above.
