"HATARANA" of London, 7,522 tons gross, whilst afloat at Cape Town on the 2nd July, 1942, and subsequently for the purpose of ascertaining the nature and extent of the damage stated to have been sustained through heavy weather on the 27th and 28th June 1942 whilst on a voyage from Durban to Cape Town.

On examination the undersigned found the following damage and made recommendations for repairs as under:-

| 3. Wood deck sheathing in way of awning stanchion and steam pipe casing splintered and started. | To be renewed. |
| 4. Cement deck covering on fore-castle head broken in one place. | To be renewed. |
| 5. Hand rails after end of fore-castle head bent and adrift. | To be faired and repaired as necessary and refastened. |
| 6. Fore-castle head breakwater movable sections washed over-board, slides of same damaged. | Movable section to be renewed slides to be repaired. |
| 7. Fore-castle galley funnel badly buckled and adrift. | To be renewed. |

Welded patches to be fitted.

12. No. 5 boat ladder washed overboard.

To be renewed.

13. Windlass steam pipes on forecastle head twisted.

To be renewed.

14. Lead suction pipe of main engine sanitary pump fractured.

To be repaired.

15. Winch balance weight lever fractured.

To be renewed.

16. Three winch drain cocks broken off.

To be renewed.

The above repairs have now been efficiently carried out.
