the undersigned Surveyor to this Society did at the request of Messrs Ruston & Hornsby, Ltd., attend at their works at Lincoln on the 4th September, 1933 and subsequent dates, for the purpose of inspecting Four Auxiliary Oil Engines Nos. 170053, 170054, 170055 and 170056, Mark 5 VORZ, each of 150 Brake Horse Power and intended for fitting on board the M.V. "INCOMATI" (Messrs Workman Clark & Co., Ltd's Yard No. 532.

These engines have been built under special survey and in accordance with the Rules of, and plans as approved by, this Society, they have been examined and tested throughout their construction and the materials and workmanship found satisfactory.

Running tests were carried out in Messrs Ruston & Hornsby Ltd's works under full load driving generators direct.

After completion of running trials, the main working parts of each engine were opened out for inspection and found satisfactory.
