Dear Sirs,

E. With reference to Yard No.748 building by Messrs. Bremer Vulkan, I have to acquaint you that a Representative of the Owners has called at this Office and discussed the question of the lighting and ventilating of the hospital, which is situated in the centre castle space immediately adjacent to the oil tanks.

The Rules do not permit switches or open type motors in tween deck and similar spaces, but special consideration has been given to this case and it is thought that no exception need be taken to the use of flameproof switches and lighting fittings in the hospital in this instance.

I have to add that the fitting of an electric fan in the hospital could not be approved, but it is considered that an arrangement whereby the fan is located on the deck above and connected by trunking to the cabin for blowing air into the latter might be accepted.
