Mr. Lowrie, representing the Owners, called yesterday afternoon with reference to the lighting and ventilating of the hospital which is located in the centre castle space immediately adjacent to the oil tanks.

The Rules do not permit switches or open type motors in tween deck and similar spaces.

Favourable consideration might be given to the use of flameproof switches and fittings in this instance.

Also that an electric fan in the hospital is not permissible but an arrangement whereby the fan is located on the deck above and connected by trunking to the cabin for blowing air into the latter might be accepted.
