

Dear Sir,

With reference to your letter of the 28th ult. regarding the built welded quadrants for Messrs. Bremer Vulkan's Yard Nos. 748, 749, and 750 I now enclose a sketch showing the strengthening which was arranged for the "INVERLEE", Yard No. 748, and similar strengthening will be fitted to the two sisterships.

A large number of these quadrants for various Classification Societies have been built and the designers and makers are of the opinion that they are not only strong enough but that they are stronger than a cast steel quadrant of approved design for the same diameter of rudder. It is their intention to carry out comparative destructive tests of the two types, the results of which will be communicated to London and it is probable a representative of Messrs. A. E. G., who have designed the quadrants, will discuss the matter in London in the near future.
