

With reference to your remark "Plan of strengthening of forwd. bottom to be submitted" on the plan of Midship Section of Messrs. Bremer Vulkan's yard Nos. 748-750, approved 10.11.36, I have discussed this matter with the Builders and found that they assume that the strengthening of forward bottom has already been approved on the profile plan on the 4.1.1937. This profile plan shows additional intermediate girders in deep tank and abaft forward cofferdam in cargo oil tank No. 1,- double riveted frames 150 mm. in deep tank and single riveted bottom frames bulb 280 x 90 abaft forw. cofferdam. As I am doubtful, whether the opinion of the Yard is right, or you are still waiting for a special plan showing the strengthening of the forw. bottom in all particulars, I would feel much obliged for having your information in this case.
