"In the plan there is an additional half height girder below the engine indicated in red. As this Motor, in alteration of former arrangements, has only one row of holding down bolts, it is in our opinion not necessary to have the required half height side girder fitted, and we would therefore feel obliged if you would reconsider this case. A sketch of the engine bed plate is attached. We would be glad if it could be dealt with at an early convenience."
