Having reference to the plan of Midship Section for Messrs. Bremer Vulkan's Yard Nos. 748-750 and the note:—"End connections of main girders and similar attachments to be welded by electrodes complying with para. 1-7", we discussed the different weldings with the Builders and informed them that the weldings of longitudinal girder ends to transverse bulkheads and vertical webs to transverse bulkheads should be made with para. 7 electrodes in the same manner as also done in their yard Nos. 718 and 727 in accordance with your letter M. of the 30th September 1935.

As the Builders now asked in a letter for your reconsideration and decision, we would feel much obliged for being informed what electrodes should be used for these web- and girder connections to the transverse bulkheads.
