S. I duly received your letter of the 20th ultimo having reference to the computation of fees for the survey during construction of machinery in vessels fitted with L.P. turbines.

Your suggestions have been carefully noted and are concurred in, so that in all future cases where fees are charged for the survey of L.P. turbines and compressors at works other than those of the Makers of the main engines, the fees chargeable to the main engine Builders should not take into account the power of such turbines or compressors.


