Cockburns, Ltd. attend at their Works at Cardonald, on the 18th June, 1937, for the purpose of surveying 6 - 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Gun Metal Non-Return Auxiliary Feed Check Valves, to the order of Messrs. Babcock & Wilcox, Ltd., for their Job No. 6/1320/1.

The valves were subjected to an hydraulic pressure of 600 lb. per square inch, shewed no signs of weakness, and were found tight and sound in every respect at that pressure.

For purposes of identification the valves are stamped:-
