

I return herewith one copy of the plan, forwarded with your letter of the 27th ultimo, of "OAP-SLM" type steam traps, proposed by Messrs. United States Metallic Packing Co. for the above contracts, and I have to inform you that this plan will be approved for a working pressure of 250 lb. per square inch and a steam temperature of 650°F., provided the steel castings be made at an approved works and tested as required by the Rules, the internal fittings of the steam traps be made from materials suitable for use with superheated steam, and the whole of the work be carried out under the usual conditions of survey and testing.

The remaining copy of the plan has been forwarded to the Society's Surveyors at Sheffield for their guidance in dealing with this case.
