Sea valves and cocks and their fittings opened out and examined, except P.S. sanitary injection which was fitted in Glasgow.

Afterwards when the vessel was afloat it was found that the Port sanitary injection valve whould not shut off. The injection was blanked off by diver and opened up when it was found the spindles had backed out of nuts. These were satisfactorily replaced and nut locked with split pin.


