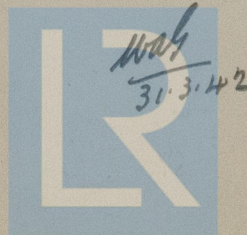

at the "Owners' convenience, to sternframe (p.s) E.W. 5.40, and shell plates G2 (s.s.) E.W. 3.42 & G4 (s.s.) E.W. 6.41 being specially examined at the next dry docking and to defective shell rivets in No.2 hold (s.s.) being permanently dealt with at the first opportunity.
