With reference to your letter of the 2nd instant, respecting the fee chargeable to the Department of the Controller General of Merchant Shipbuilding in the case of the S.S. GORALA", Messrs. Workman Clark & Co's No.444 vessel, I have to inform you that 50% of the difference of the fees as a Standard Vessel and the ordinary classification fees both for the Hull and Machinery, will be chargeable to the Ministry of Shipping, which will be as under:-

" " " Machinery.....	34.	0.	0.


