The class is subject to indented shell plate G5 from aft (s.s.) being dealt with at the first opportunity, to permanent repairs to (cracked) shell plate No.5 in 4th strake below sheer (p.s.) at the Owners' convenience and to indented counter plates etc. at the earliest convenient opportunity.

The NEWCASTLE, N.S.W. Surveyors report (10.42) the vessel afloat and repairs to counter plating etc. effected.


IT IS SUBMITTED the vessel is worthy to remain as classed, subject as above, except as regards counter plating etc.
