Parts now examined:—

STARBOARD MAIN ENGINE. No.6 cylinder, cover, valves and valve gear, liner, piston, gudgeon pin and its eccentric bush, connecting rod, crankpin, brasses and crank webs.  
No.8 Main bearing top half brass and journal.  
No.2 (or After Port) Auxiliary Engine. Compressor and Nos. 1 & 5 cylinders, liners, pistons, valves, connecting rods, gudgeon pins and brasses, crankpins, webs and brasses, intercoolers and aftercooler examined and found good.  
Armature clearances of No.2 Auxiliary Engine were tested and found to be .079" top and .077" bottom.  
Nos. 1 & 6 main bearing top halves and journals (No.2 Auxiliary Engine)  
This completes the survey on this No.2 Auxiliary Engine except No.7 bearing and journal which have yet to be examined.
