Dear Sirs,

T. I am in receipt of Mr. Dodd's letter of the 24th March with which he enclosed his report on the steamer "LA CARRIERE" in triplicate, and thank him for his attention in this matter. The report has been forwarded to the Owners who state they are considering it and, should any question arise thereon, they will communicate with me later.

A total charge of £91:10:0 has been made for your services in this matter, and this amount, which has been paid, has been credited to the Mobile account. You should therefore pass the payment through your Cash Book upon receipt of this letter, taking as the dollar equivalent the sum of \$428.70.
