I beg to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 18th instant relating to an order you have received for a 45 Kw. generating set to be fitted in the above vessel, and note that as you are unable to obtain from your suppliers an air receiver made to this Society's tests and requirements in less than 20 weeks, you desire to use one taken from stock, the material of which has not been tested by the Society's Surveyors.

The plan submitted has been examined, and I am directed to inform you that, in all the circumstances, no objection will be taken in this instance to your proposal to use a stock Air Receiver which has not been tested by the Society's Surveyors, provided the quality and results of the tests of the material as shown on the Makers' Certificate be in accordance with the Society's Rules, the scantlings be as indicated on the plan, and the Receiver be tested by the Society's Surveyors and found satisfactory under an
