E. I duly received your letter of the 10th instant, with enclosures, relating to The Wallsend Slipway & Engineering Co's Contract No. 933, Messrs. Swan, Hunter & Wigham Richardson Ltd., Yard No. 1555, and I have to inform you that the plans of superheaters will be approved for a working pressure of 220 lb. per sq. inch, provided the steel forgings be made at approved works and tested as required by this Society's Rules, a safety valve be fitted to each part of the superheaters which can be isolated from the boilers, the superheaters be constructed under the usual conditions of survey and testing, and the whole be tested to three times the working pressure.

One set of the plans now approved is returned herewith. I take this opportunity of enclosing the usual Survey Request Form, which I shall be obliged if you will kindly complete and return to this Office in due course.
