With reference to your letter of the 22nd April last respecting the steamer "LLANCARVAN", I beg to acquaint you the Committee have now had before them a report on this vessel received from the Society's Surveyors at Lisbon to the effect that the reduction gearing of the White's Combined Steam Reciprocating and Turbine Unit was examined at that port last month. The teeth of the turbine primary pinion and wheel were found damaged. The pinion shaft was removed pending renewal. The turbine is now out of use and the Surveyors recommend that the turbine reduction gearing be repaired on the vessel's arrival in the United Kingdom. The vessel's class has accordingly been continued subject to this being done.
