Referring to the recent correspondence regarding the test certificates for above plants, we are informed by Lloyd's Register of Shipping, Glasgow, that no dynamo Certificates have been received for 439 & 440.

Will you please be good enough therefore, to inform the representative of Lloyd's Register who witnessed the dynamo tests, to forward the certificates to their Glasgow Office at once.

We are sorry to inconvenience you again in this matter but the trouble appears to be caused through Lloyd's Register's representative not forwarding the certificates to the port where the vessel is being built.

It may be that he is not aware that this procedure is necessary but we shall be obliged if you will bring this matter to his notice either your goodselves, or through the dynamo-makers.
