Notations of 100A- Classification Contemplated "For Restricted U.K. Coastal Service" and 'Examined 5.42' valid for 12 months have been assigned to this Polish vessel.

A further GENERAL EXAMINATION has been held, but the assignment of the notation of 'Examined 10.43' has been withheld pending important repairs. In the meantime the vessel's present service is restricted as above.

The Glasgow Office state that this vessel was taken over by the Admiralty for a "special purpose" and no further surveys are anticipated.

It is accordingly submitted her notations be omitted from the Register Book.
