In reply to your enquiry regarding the above vessel, we have to inform you that owing to the congestion of work at this Port and pressure on the Dry Docking facilities, it was decided after arrival that the work could not be undertaken here. A licence was subsequently issued by the Ministry of Shipping for the required alterations and repairs to be effected at Penarth. It was then found, however, that certain Boiler repairs would be required to enable the Vessel to proceed to the Bristol Channel and arrangements are now being made to get these done.
