Not in the Register Book.


The Manchester Surveyors forward a copy of a letter they have received from Messrs. Ellerman & Papayanni Lines Ltd., in which they state that this vessel has lately been employed as a Polish Training Vessel and the Owners, the Polish Steamship Agency Ltd., of London, desire her to be classed with this Society. No plans are available.

The vessel was to leave Liverpool for Manchester on the 23rd instant and they desire the Surveyors at the latter port to start the inspection with a view to granting a Seaworthy Certificate if possible for a period of twelve months.

It is submitted the Manchester Surveyors be informed that it will be necessary for the requirements of a ^{3rd} 2nd Special survey No.3 to be complied with, and in addition the particulars of scantlings, equipment &c. should be reported on a First Entry report Form.

In the event of the survey not being completed at Manchester the vessel should be generally examined in accordance with the instructions set forth in Circular No. 1764 and placed in a satisfactory condition for a period of six months with a view to 100A1 "Class Contemplated" "Examined (with date)" being recorded in the Register Book.

The question of fees will be decided when the particulars of tonnage &c. are known.
