Dear Sir,

With reference to my letter of the 5th instant respecting the Steamer "WILJA", I have to acquaint you that to enable this vessel to be classed with this Society it will be necessary for the requirements of the Rules for vessels not built under survey to be complied with, and in addition to a report on form 8, detailed particulars of scantlings, equipment etc., will require to be reported on First Entry report form. The requirements of a 3rd Special Survey No.3 will require to be complied with.

As it appears that plans will not be available, information in the First Entry report form might be supplemented by sketches of midship section and profile.

As regards the machinery, sketches of boilers and pumping arrangements should be furnished by the Surveyors, and the engines, boilers, and electrical equipment should be examined completely, the screwshaft drawn, and a First Entry Report and a Report 9 should also be furnished. The steam pipes are required to be tested.
