Scantling Nos:- 15251 and 39267

Proportions:- Length = 10.85 depths to upper deck.

In submitting a sketch shewing scarphing arrangements
at second deck (see letter dated 9.10.39) Messrs. Sir Joseph W.
Isherwood & Co.Ltd. give yard numbers 440, 441 & 446. Plans
for Nos. 440 & 441 (also No. 439) have already been approved,
and in reply to a telephonic enquiry Messrs. Isherwood state
that No. 446 is to be constructed as a duplicate of Nos. 439,
440 & 441.

It is submitted that provided the vessel be built in
accordance with the plans approved for the sister ships referred
to

she will be eligible to be classed 100A1 with a freeboard
corresponding to a draught not exceeding that contemplated by
the Rules for a complete superstructure vessel having a tonnage
opening, with the notations "Longitudinal framing at bottom and
at deck" and "Arcform".

The Greenock Surveyors should be advised and requested
to endorse the approved/hull plans with the new yard number.
