The class is subject to indented keel plate No.2 and shell plates A.3 and D.4 (p.s) and A.3 & 4 (s.s) all from aft, being dealt with at the Owners' convenience.

The SYDNEY N.S.W. Surveyors report (5,42) the vessel placed in dry dock, bottom coated, decks hatchways, ventilators etc. examined and found in good condition.

The indented plating, as above, continues efficient.

It is submitted the vessel appears worthy to remain as classed with record of docking survey 5,42 subject as above.
