LLANDAFF CASTLE. — Johannesburg, Dec. 5.—The naval authorities to-day advised the Union-Castle Company that survivors of the steamer Llandaff Castle, which was sunk in the Indian Ocean with a number of South African soldiers going home on leave, totalled to date 280, leaving few, if any, unaccounted for. Individual details are not yet available. —Reuter.
