Dear Sirs,

I return herewith one copy of the plan, forwarded with your letter of the 25th ultimo, of Boiler Room Pipe Arrangement proposed by Messrs. Harland & Wolff, Ltd. for the s.s. "LLANDAFF CASTLE", and have to inform you that this plan will be approved, provided the arrangements be as shown and amended thereon and the remaining requirements of Section 20 of the Rules (1938-9) be complied with so far as they are applicable.

It is noted that the new lengths of waste steam pipes Nos. 485/6/7/8/9 are only $3\frac{1}{2}$ " and $4\frac{1}{2}$ " diameter, instead of 4" and $5\frac{1}{2}$ " diameter respectively, in the case of the existing pipes which they join, and it is concluded that the original safety valves have been replaced by improved high lift safety valves of approved type. I shall be glad, however, to receive confirmation of this.
