M Mr. Brewer, the Superintendent for the David Steamship Co., has forwarded to this Office the test certificates for the anchors and chain cables of the steamer "CESARIO" ex "D.A.D.G.76", which vessel is now under your survey, and with regard thereto I have to inform you that in the circumstances the equipment as shewn on the certificates will be accepted for the Figure 1, but without the notation "Lloyd's A.&C.P.".

The certificates in question are sent herewith and I have to request that you will satisfy yourselves that they correspond with the anchors and chain cables actually on board the ship.

The towline, stream wire, hawsers &c. should be equivalent to those corresponding to Equipment Letter b† in Table 31 of the Rules.
