M I duly received your letter of the 8th instant enclosing anchor and chain cable certificates of the steamer "CESARIO" ex "D.A.D.G.76", and with regard thereto I have pleasure in stating that in the circumstances the equipment as shewn on the certificates will be accepted for the Figure 1, but without the notation "Lloyd's A.&C.P.".

The test certificates in question are being forwarded to the Society's Surveyors at Amsterdam, who are being requested to satisfy themselves that the certificates correspond with the anchors and chain cables actually on board the vessels.

The towline, stream wire, hawsers &c. should be equivalent to those corresponding to Equipment Letter **†** in Table 31 of the Rules.
