Dear Sirs,

M. I return herewith the plans, forwarded with Mr. Leeuwenburg's letter of the 11th instant, of the deep tank which it is proposed to build in the second hold abaft the engine room of the S.S. "CESARIO", and with regard thereto I have to state that provided the arrangements be carried out as shown and amended on the plans and to your satisfaction, the same will be approved.

You should satisfy yourselves as to the condition of the existing structure which will form part of the deep tank. The tank should be tested as required by the Rules.

It may be added that the scantlings and arrangements have been considered on the understanding that the tank will be used for the carriage of ordinary cargo or water ballast.

It is noted that a new plan will be forwarded for consideration as soon as it is received from the Builders, and a plan of the amended pumping arrangements should also be submitted.
