I am in receipt of Mr. Blackwood's letter of the 25th instant respecting the ex-German Steamer "D. A. D. G. 76", and with regard to this case I have to acquaint you that Mr. Brewer, the new Owners' representative, states that this vessel is leaving your port for Rotterdam, where it is the Owners' intention to fit a deep tank, and in these circumstances, it is probable that the sand ballast will be removed from above No. 7 tank, which will enable the tank to be examined internally and tested.

In the circumstances, I have to request that you will forward your reports immediately and state what still remains to be done to complete the classification survey, in order that full instructions may be sent to the Rotterdam Surveyors.
