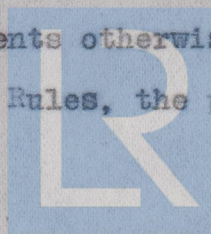

Dear Sirs,

With reference to Messrs. Blackwood and Robertson's letters of the 15th instant submitting for the consideration of the Committee plans of the main boilers and pumping arrangements of the S.S. "D.A.D.G. 76", now under survey at your port with a view to classification with this Society, I have to acquaint you that provided the boilers on examination be found in good order and safe working condition, and their scantlings be in accordance with the plan, the boilers will be accepted in this instance for a working pressure of 225 lbs. per square inch.

I have further to state that provided a donkey pump separate bilge suction be fitted in the engine room, if not already supplied; the draining arrangement of the fore peak tank top flat and chain locker be to your satisfaction; the Owners undertake to fit hand pumps or their equivalent if required by the Society to do so in the future, and the arrangements otherwise be in accordance with the requirements of the Rules, the pumping arrangements will be accepted.
