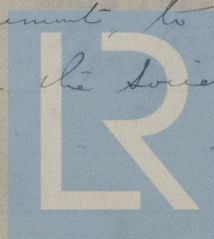
For the CHIEF SHIP SURVEYOR and CHIEF ENGINEER SURVEYOR.
