We duly received your letter of the 13th instant respecting steamer "MIRLO" and beg to inform you that we have today received letter from the owner, which translated reads as follows:-

In regard to your letter of the 17th instant we beg to inform you, that in a letter from Baumont dated 22nd April the master states, that the bolted doors in the cofferdam bulkhead, 4 in numbers, were rivetted at Baumont, before the loading was started and this is supposed to be in order, but we have, I am sorry to say, no information if they have had Lloyd's Surveyor to examine the work, but we take it for granted as it was a requirement from the builders."
