Dear Sirs,

With reference to my cablegram of the 2nd March
 respecting the steamer "MIRLO", I have to acquaint you
 that the Society's Surveyor at Newport News stated on the 12th
 of March that the vessel sailed for Beaumont, Texas on the 11th
 of March and that no suitable opportunity presented itself for
 making an examination of the plate doors in the after cofferdam
 bulkheads between the summer tanks and the coal or oil fuel
 tanks.

The Society's Surveyors at Newcastle state that
 they cannot obtain any information from the Owner's Agents
 respecting the vessel's movements, and I shall therefore be
 glad if you will kindly ascertain from the Owner and let
 me know what arrangements he proposes making for the bolted
 doors in the after cofferdam bulkheads to be riveted up.
